October 27, 2022 Re: Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)

Respiratory Syncytial Virus is a common respiratory virus that usually causes mild, cold-like symptoms. It causes infections of the lungs and respiratory tract.

- Other symptoms are more likely to lead to pneumonia
- The virus is usually spread through direct contact with an infected person
- Protect yourself and others from getting sick. Wash your hands with soap and water. If soap and water is not available, use a hand sanitizer that has been licensed by a governing authority.
- Wash or sanitize hands:
 - After coughing or sneezing
 - When caring for others
 - Before, during and after you prepare food
 - Before eating
 - After using the washroom/toilet
 - After handling animals or animal waste
